Thank you for your continued support as we all work together to keep our community as safe as possible from COVID-19. We tested 86 people last week and had no new positive results!

As of this writing, Floyd County's positivity rate has gone down to 3.1%.

25 additional staff receive their first round of vaccines on Monday, March 15, 2021 from Transitions Hospice. We thank them for thinking of us. We are working towards a 100% vaccinated campus!

The best news is that anyone post-14 days of *both* rounds of the vaccine DO NOT have to test any longer! Unless you have any symptoms or are in a situation that makes you uncomfortable because of size of event or close proximity to people you do not know, testing is no longer necessary!

We look forward to the CDC's and Greenbrier Senior Living's guidelines for post-vaccine protocols for what our future will look like. We will publish those guidelines as soon as we receive them.

No updates have been received from the health department regarding dining and the guidelines for opening dining rooms completely.

The Governor has renewed the Public Health State of Emergency until April 6, 2021.
